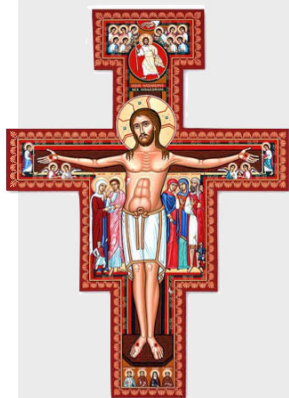

**The Feast of Mercy - A Day of Extraordinary Grace**  
 In a series of revelations to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord repeatedly called for the celebration of the Feast of Mercy on the first Sunday after Easter. He promised an ocean of graces to be poured upon the world. Today, we know this feast as Devine Mercy Sunday, named by St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000.  
**We will recite the Divine Mercy Chaplet immediately after each Mass the weekend of April 15 & 16. It only takes 10 minutes to say. Please plan on giving Our Lord an extra 10 minutes.**

The Devotion to the Divine Mercy is based on the private revelations of Jesus to Polish Saint Faustina in the 1930's. It recognizes God as infinite mercy and involves a decision to accept God's mercy with thanksgiving, to trust in Him, and to be merciful as He is merciful. One element of the devotion is the Divine Mercy Chaplet, a form of prayer using Rosary beads. The Recitation of the Chaplet is prayed each Monday evening from 5:30 to 6:00 PM in the small chapel. All are welcome!

The Catholic faith, rich with traditions and devotions, will embark on a three year Eucharistic Revival in the United States. The Diocese of Shreveport will offer events throughout 2022-2023 that will encourage growth in understanding and devotion to Christ in the Eucharist, complemented by online formation and resources that will raise up Eucharistic Missionaries at all levels of the Church. The Holy Hour will begin at 2:30 PM and will include the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Veneration of the Divine Mercy image. The faithful are encouraged to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation either the week preceding or the week following the Holy Hour in order to meet the requirements of the Plenary Indulgence attached to this devotion. However, limited opportunity to attend the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available during and after the Holy Hour. The Reverend Peter B. Mangum, Rector of the Cathedral, will preside. Please join us for this wonderful opportunity to experience God's unfathomable mercy!

**HOW TO PRAY THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY**

- 1. Sign of the Cross**  
In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- 2. Our Father**  
Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.
- 3. Hail Mary**  
Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus, Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, Amen.
- 4. Apostle's Creed**  
I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.
- 5. On each of the Large Beads**  
Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearliest Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- 6. On each of the Small Beads**  
For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

**After Praying All 5 Decades**

- 7. Concluding Doxology (Repeat 3x)**  
Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- 8. Closing Prayer (optional)**  
Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become dependent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
