



You are Invited! Noon, Tuesday, September 26, 2023 Holy Trinity Catholic Church 315 Marshall Street Shreveport, LA 71101

This year is the 150th anniversary of the Shreveport Yellow Fever Epidemic. As many of you know, the five priests who fell ill and died caring for the sick and dying are being proposed for sainthood, and their cause has been accepted by the Church. On Tuesday, September 26, there will be Mass at noon at Holy Trinity Catholic Church in Shreveport honoring Father Jean Marie Biler, Chaplain at St. Vincent's, and the Daughters of the Cross, three of whom also died while serving the stricken. They were Sister Marie Marthe Denes, Sister Marie Angele le Nedelec, and Sister Rose of Lima Desselles. Sister Margaret Rose Cano, now a Marianite of the Holy Cross living in Lafayette, is planning to attend. All former students of the Daughters of the Cross are also invited, and Father Duane Trombetta is going to reserve a section for us. A light lunch will follow at St. John's Parish Hall.
