

- **Q:** Why did the Clergy & Staff expense drop from 48k last quarter to 30k this quarter?
- A: Previously, St Thomas was paying 100% of Father Charles and Father Kevin's salaries & benefits. In November, St Lucy of Hodge began paying a portion of these expenses and reimbursed St Thomas back to July of 2024. Going forward a portion of clergy expenses will be shared between St Thomas and St Lucy.
- Q: Why is the Insurance expense so high this quarter?
- A: We pay our property insurance annually in the fall. Our property insurance premium this fall was 32k.
